- ___ Check payable to VFW Post 402 (please annotate MTBP in the memo block)
- ___ A good quality military photograph or image file (photos will be scanned and returned, if digital photo is provided it must be scanned at 600 dpi) This should not be sent in with the application but when application is approved.
- ___ Copy of Military Members DD 214 or other document to verify service
