THIS PROJECT IS TO SHOW OUR APPRECIATION TO THE MEN AND WOMEN FROM OUR AREA WHO HAVE SERVED OR ARE CURRENTLY SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES.

Military banners will be displayed on utility poles along Kellys Way and side streets if needed. The veteran's picture will be on both sides of the banner, along with name, rank and branch of service. Banners will be displayed from Memorial Day through Veteran's Day.

The cost for 1 - 24" X 36" double sided banner is **\$125.00**, which includes the hardware for hanging. A 12" X 18" yard banner for personal use may be purchased for an additional **\$10.00**, with the purchase of a street banner order.

After Veteran's Day, banners will be stored for the following year's display. A **\$10** maintenance fee must be paid PRIOR to your banner being hung the following year.

Veteran Criteria include those on active duty in any armed service, an honorably discharged veteran and those who gave their lives for their country. They also must currently live in the East Brady, Bradys Bend, Seybertown, Hillville, Queenstown or must have lived within the old East Brady High School attendance area when joining the military.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Applications will be available at the East Brady Borough office, Farmers National Bank (East Brady Branch) and Bracken's Pharmacy in East Brady.

Applications will be accepted November 1, 2016 – March 1, 2017. Application on next page.

Completed application, photo and payment may be taken to the East Brady Borough Office for scanning Monday – Friday from 1 – 4 pm, November 1-March 1. Applications will be processed in the order received. You may also mail to East Brady Borough, 502 Ferry St. Suite 15, East Brady, PA 16028
