

Bethel Park Military Banner Program

The Military Banner Program salutes our brave men and women who are currently serving and those who have served in the military by creating and displaying a 24" x 36" military banner to be exhibited in Bethel Park between Memorial Day and Veterans' Day for years to come.

The cost to join the program includes:

- 1) 1 - 24" x 36" Military Banner to be displayed by the borough
- 2) 1 - 24" x 36" Military Banner or Two 12" x 18" banners for personal display
- 3) 1 - Bracket to hold the banner while displayed
- 4) 1 - Mounting hardware to hang the bracket on a telephone pole
- 5) Web presence on the Bethel Park and American Legion websites

Typical life span of banners is 4 to 5 years, however, over time extreme heat, wind and rain may cause them to crack, rip or fade. There is a \$45.00 cost to replace the Display Banner.
